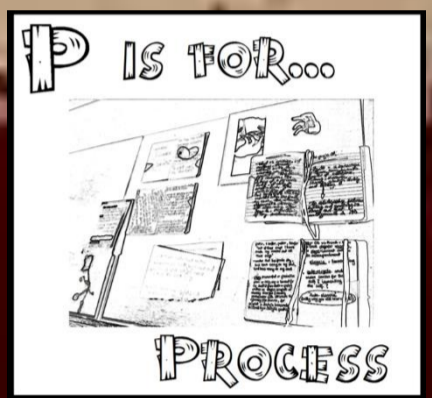

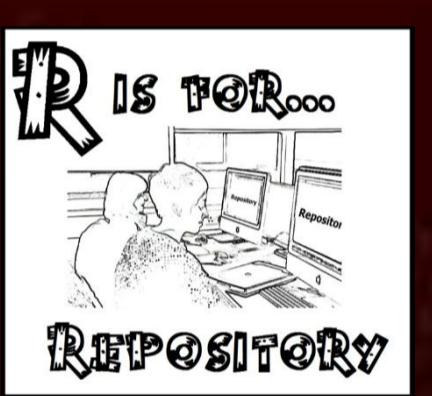

- Development of user case studies and scenarios for demonstration purposes



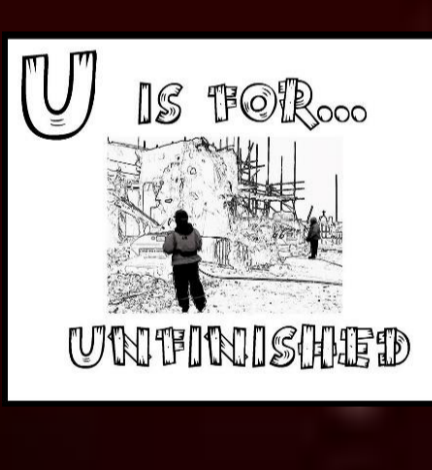
